The school year is off to a great start. We thought an early “Friday” Forecast might be in order to answer a few questions. The Forecast will normally be emailed on Thursday afternoon, will be posted in Sycamore documents, and linked on the website. Hard copies will be sent home with preschool and kindergarten to mark menu selections. Copies should be returned on Wednesday this week, and usually on Monday.

If you have children in preschool or elementary, please make a note of the elementary direct line shown above. The new elementary secretary is Mrs. Amanda Booth. The main number rings into the high school office, and we are happy to transfer your call. You can save a step by calling the elementary directly.

LUNCH MENU

Regular lunch line will resume on Wednesday. The menu for the next three days is on page 3. Lunch money may be deposited in an account which works like a checking account. You may send money with your student (in a clearly-marked envelope), or bring a check or cash to either office. You may monitor your child’s expenditures in Sycamore. Click “My Accounting / Cafeteria” to see daily expenditures or the remaining balance. Email reminders are sent when the balance falls below \$10.00.

TRAFFIC PATTERNS

Remember the one-way traffic pattern for 7-12. In the morning, enter on the east, drive behind the building, drop off students at door #7, exit on the west. If you need to come into the office, please park out of the traffic pattern away from the building. In the afternoon, you may park in the lot while waiting for your students. Remember that school dismisses at 3:15 this year. You may exit from the east side. Follow the lanes for left or right turns as you exit.

7-12 students who are not picked up by 3:25 will report to the designated study room until 4:00 p.m. Students remaining at 4:00 will be transported by a staff member to the elementary extended care and may be picked up there. When there are only 1 or 2 students, we may take them to extended care at 3:25.

DRESS CODE

LUNCH MENU: All *a la carte* items are available EVERY DAY at the indicated prices **except** those marked “extra” which are only available on days they are included in the featured entrée.

Lunch is offered on a **CASH ONLY** basis. That doesn’t mean you can’t write a check; it means you can’t charge lunches if there is no money in the account. We encourage depositing money in a student’s or family account. In Sycamore you can see your balance as well as exact charges incurred by each child. Go to My Accounting/Cafeteria. Daily entrée is \$2.50. Combo meals are also \$2.50, but the side portions are smaller than *a la carte*. When combo meals include fries, an extra order (small) of fries is \$1.25.

JR HI treats are prepared by 8th grade students & sold at \$1.00 each, usually on Wednesdays, to fund the class trip to Chicago in May.
