### **DRESS CODE**

#### **4.4 Preschool and Kindergarten (PK3, PK4, K5)**

- 4.4.1 All PK3, PK4 & K5 students must purchase at least one school logo shirt which is required attire for all field trips.
- 4.4.2 Boys may wear T-shirts or polo shirts with jeans, shorts, or sweatpants.
- 4.4.3 Girls may also wear T-shirts or polo shirts with jeans, shorts, or sweatpants.
- 4.4.4 Girls’ dresses or skirts must be no shorter than the middle of the knee when standing. Girls may wear shorts under their skirts/dresses, but the skirts must cover the shorts.
- 4.4.5 Shirts/blouses must have sleeves. Spaghetti straps, tank tops, tight, sleeveless, sheer, or see-through clothes are not permitted.
- 4.4.6 Leggings are not considered pants and must be worn under a skirt.
- 4.4.7 Both boys and girls must wear shoes.
- 4.4.8 Boys’ hair should be neatly trimmed and off the collar.

#### **Dress Code Guidelines Grades 1-12:**

Looking to the Bible for guidance, our goals are to honor the Lord and to encourage modest and appropriate dress.

1. All clothing should fit in a manner that is modest and neat in appearance. Clothing that is tight, immodest, and form-fitting is considered unacceptable. The “pinch an inch” rule through the hips and thighs is recommended for both boys and girls.
2. Girls’ pants (slacks) are permitted in grades 1-12 in the solid colors of khaki, navy or black. No jeans.
3. Girls may wear leggings under a dress/skirt that is to the middle of the knee. Tunics are not dresses.
4. Boys in grades 1-6 are permitted to wear denim jeans in addition to khaki-fabric pants in black, navy or khaki (tan).

#### **LOGO SHIRTS (PK3-12)**

**At least one blue shirt with the school logo is required for all students for field trips at all levels, on designated days throughout the year, and all bands and choirs for the fall concert (with khaki pants or skirt).**

We have a local supplier for logo shirts and will stock a variety of sizes for your convenience in the school offices. Shirt sizes for PK3-grade 6 are available in the elementary office only. Shirts may also be ordered from Land’s End.
