HERITAGE HALL WEATHER DELAY and CLOSING INFORMATION

1. HHCS may have a 2-hour delay but will not close early.
Parents should use their own judgment about driving or sending student drivers to school. We realize that conditions may be worse in the county, and many of our families have a long drive. Safety is our first concern.
2. School closing will be announced by 5:30 AM on the following stations: RTV6, WTHR-13, WISH-TV8
Watch the banner across the TV screen. Do not be confused by *Heritage Christian, Indianapolis*.
Parents who have signed the permission form will also be notified through School Messenger by text, email or voicemail.
3. When we have a 2-hour delay, preschool and half-day kindergarten classes will meet. However, we realize that the scheduling may be difficult to bring a student at 10:00 and pick them up again at 11:30. Please use your own judgment. Students will not be penalized if they do not attend on that day.
4. On a two-hour delay secondary class periods will be adjusted so that all morning classes will meet.
5. If snow starts during the school day, and you plan to pick up your students early or want your student driver to start for home early, please call the office.
Extended care will remain open until 5:30 unless another emergency arises (power outage, leaks).
6. The Administration checks weather conditions and is aware of what other school corporations are doing.
Generally, HHCS will be closed if
 Muncie Community (city schools) is closed.
 a county emergency is declared.

County schools have to be concerned with getting buses down snowy, icy, or drifted roads. Do not assume that we will be closed just because a nearby county school is closed. Check the TV and/or your phone alert to be sure.

We also realize that conditions are often much different in neighboring counties. Please do what you feel is safe for your family, especially your student drivers.

7:00-9:30 AM EXTENDED CARE (2-hour delay) POLICY

- A. Service is available at no extra charge to enrolled* families who are billed the monthly rate for extended care.
- B. Siblings of enrolled students may also come early, but will be charged \$10 per day.
- C. Non-enrolled* families will be charged a flat \$10 fee PER STUDENT for any amount of time they use the service between 7:00 and 9:30 AM.
- D. If school is subsequently cancelled because of worsening weather conditions another emergency (e.g., power outage or water pipe break), personnel will call or text the parents to pick up their students.

*Enrolled families are defined as those who use extended care daily and are billed the monthly rate. Families whose students stay one or two days a week, or maybe only occasionally, who are billed by the week are considered non-enrolled.

LUNCH MENU: All *a la carte* items are available EVERY DAY at the indicated prices **except** those marked “extra” which are only available on days they are included in the featured entrée.

Lunch is offered on a **CASH ONLY** basis. That doesn’t mean you can’t write a check; it means you can’t charge lunches if there is no money in the account. We encourage depositing money in a student’s or family account. In Sycamore you can see your balance as well as exact charges incurred by each child. Go to My Accounting/Cafeteria. Please direct any questions to Miss Hunt, the lunch account manager.

Daily entrée is \$2.50. Combo meals are also \$2.50, but the side portions are smaller than *a la carte*. When combo meals include fries, an extra order (small) of fries is \$1.25.

IMPORTANT: SOME OF OUR STUDENTS ARE ALLERGIC TO PEANUTS AND RELATED PRODUCTS. PLEASE LABEL JH TREATS CONTAINING THESE INGREDIENTS. PARENTS, PLEASE BE SURE THE TEACHER OR EXTENDED CARE WORKERS ARE AWARE OF ANY FOOD ALLERGIES.

A Kidz Meal is offered at \$3.00 for PK3, PK4, and K5 only, and includes a smaller portion entrée or combo, and a choice of Gogurt, fruit or dessert, plus a drink. Any other items may be purchased at an additional charge. Parents of PK3, PK4, and K5 children are asked to mark choices for each day and return the menu form on Monday. To order a Kidz Meal or any *a la carte* item, check the box for that day. To order soup, circle your choice. It is not necessary to return a slip for students in grade 1 or above.
