Lunch is offered on a **CASH ONLY** basis. That doesn’t mean you can’t write a check; it means you can’t charge lunches if there is no money in the account. Daily entrée is \$2.50. Combo meals are also \$2.50, but the side portions are smaller than *a la carte*. When combo meals include fries, an extra order (small) of fries is \$1.25.

Any other items may be purchased at an additional charge. Parents of PK3, PK4, and K5 children are asked to mark choices for each day and return the menu form on Monday. To order a Kidz Meal or any *a la carte* item, check the box for that day. To order soup, circle your choice. It is not necessary to return a slip for students in grade 1 or above.
