Gym Lobby Safety Policy

Safety is always our first concern for students, athletes, fans, and guests. During volleyball and basketball games in the gym, the lobby is a busy place. The lobby serves as the main entrance for teams, fans, and officials. It is also the route between the fan bleachers and concessions and to the restrooms.

Parents are responsible to supervise their own elementary and preschool children.

The staff member taking money cannot be expected to also supervise children.

We need your help to enforce the following policy during games and after-school practices. These rules will also be posted in the gym lobby.

1. No running or playing in the lobby.
2. No playing with balls of any kind.
3. No entering storage rooms even if the door is open.
4. No playing under tables or bleachers.
5. Shoes must be worn at all times.

Students found to be in violation of these policies will be escorted to their parents in the bleachers.
