IMPORTANT POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Heritage Hall Christian School

DROP OFF AND DISMISSAL: At morning drop off anytime between 7:00 and 7:55 a.m., we ask that parents let our staff and safety patrol help your child out of the car and into the building. We have staff available to let your child into the building at these times.

At dismissal,

- please **ONLY** use the car line to pick up your child(ren)
- please do **NOT** come into building (unless you have business in the office).

This helps keep our parking lot and school safe and secure during these times.

If you have a grandparent or friend dropping off or picking up your child, please notify them of this policy. We appreciate your cooperation.

PICK UP EARLY and PICK UP FOR DOCTOR APPOINTMENTS:

Our school policy is that you notify the school office and your child's teacher no later than the morning of the appointment or early pick up. This helps our teachers plan to have your child's homework ready and also alerts the office of your arrival.

A doctor's note is required to ensure an absence for a doctor appointment is excused. Notes should be turned in to the office when the student signs in (if arriving late or returning from the appointment), or on the morning following an afternoon appointment.

PARENT VISITS: Visits should be scheduled at least 24 hours in advance for parents wishing to sit in on classes. Visits must be approved by the Administrator.

LUNCH WITH STUDENTS: Parents are welcome to have lunch at school with their own students. Please follow these policies as you plan your visit.

Notify the office (elementary or high school) no later than 9:00 a.m. on the morning of the visit. If you plan to eat a school lunch, please order it at that time.

When you arrive, you **must** check in with the office to get a visitor pass **BEFORE** going to lunch with your child in the gym. You may meet the bus in the gym parking lot to enter the gym with your class (elementary). Or you may meet your student in the high school building and walk with them to the gym.

Prior approval from the Administration is required if parents desire to provide lunch for an entire class or a large group of students.

If you have a grandparent who would like to have lunch with your child, please notify them of these policies. Again, this is for the safety of our students as well as our visitors.

Former students and graduates are requested to follow this same policy. If you anticipate a visit from a friend, please remind them of the procedure.

DRESS CODE FOR VISITORS: All visitors are asked to follow our general guidelines for modesty and appropriateness when visiting our campus for any reason.
