As the first day of school approaches, we know there are still many questions. We wish we could tell you we have all the answers. Here are some reminders for next week.

- 7th Grade Parent/Student meeting**
Thursday, Aug 6, 6:30-7:30 p.m.
We will cover basic information that all 7th graders need to know regarding schedules, lockers, required activities, drop-off/pick-up, planners, cell phones, and more.
- First day of school – Friday, August 7**
Doors open at 7:00 in both buildings.
7:45 a.m. – Grades 7-12 must be seated in Fine Arts Center
7:55 a.m. – Grades PK-6th classes begin
- Lunch: All students in grades 1-12 will need to bring a lunch on August 7.**
Lunch for PK and K5 is included in tuition and will be a sack lunch.
Grades 7-12 should include a cold pack, if possible. Microwaves will not be available to students through September.
- Face coverings**
The most recent information from Gov. Holcomb's office is that face masks or face shields are required for all students in grades 3-12. You will need to provide your own masks. Please keep in mind that masks should not display any logos, characters, sayings, or pictures contrary to the Christian standards or worldview of Heritage Hall Christian School.
- Graduation Pathways**
Meeting on Tuesday, September 1, 6:30-7:30 p.m. in the Fine Arts Center for all Freshmen and Sophomores and their parents.
Effective with the Class of 2023 (current sophomores), new Pathways must be met in addition to core classes, grades, and testing. We will conduct temperature checks for all faculty, staff and students every morning. Parents are asked to remain until the student has been cleared to enter the building.
